## SETTING GEAR: Complete #1-#14 about the start of the trip and setting your pot or longline gear

- 1** Year
- 2a** Permit - **CIRCLE** the permit type used this trip. LE DTL should be circled for LE vessels outside of the primary tier time period.
- 2b** Permit # - Record permit #. No Permit # = Open Access
- 2c** EFP Trip - **CIRCLE** Yes or No to indicate if this is an EFP Trip.
- 3** Vessel Name
- 4** Port of Landing
- 5** Vessel Doc. Number
- 6** Buyer(s) - List all buyers
- 7** Gear - **CIRCLE** the type of gear used (pot, barrel, bucket, longline, or other). *If other is circled, explain in the comments.*

### Complete #8a-e if using Pots

- 8a** Type of Pot – **CIRCLE** the type of pot used on this trip (rectangular, conical, or other). *If other is circled, explain in comments.*
- 8b** Dimensions of Pot - Print the size of the pots, barrels, or buckets fished in feet (Example: (H) 4.5' x (W) 3' x (L) 5').

- 8c** Escapement Hole Size - Print the diameter in inches of the escapement hole or ring.
- 8d** Number of Escapement Holes - Print the average number of escapement holes in the pots, barrels, or buckets.
- 8e** Pot/Barrel/Bucket Spacing - Print the average number of feet that the pots, barrels, or buckets are placed apart on the line.

### Complete #9a-c if using Longline

- 9a** Type of Longline Gear – **CIRCLE** the type of longline gear used on this trip (FIXED HOOK, AUTO LINE, or SNAP gear).
- 9b** Longline Gear ID - (A)  
Record gear qualities about the unique strings used.

- Use the second line **(B)** for different gear information recorded on this page.

- 9c** LL Gear ID (A or B) - Record the letter from the Longline Gear ID box that describes the gear used for each set.
- 10** String or Set # - Print your identifying code (used by you to identify each particular string) for each string of pots, barrels, buckets, or string of hooks.
- 11** # of Skates, Tubs, or Pots per Set - Record the number of skates or tubs for longline gear or number of pots for pot gear.
- 12** Set Date & Time (24 Hour Clock) - Print the month/date, and time (24 hour clock) that the gear was set. "Set" and "up" dates may be different days.  
08:00am = 0800 1:00pm = 1300
- 13** Depth (Fm) - Print the bottom depths (in fathoms) at the start & end of the string set.
- 14** Latitude & Longitude - Record both latitude and longitude in Degrees & Decimal Minutes where the gear was set for the start of the string (Start) and for the end of the string (End).

## RETRIEVING GEAR: Complete #15-#24 about hauling back your pot or longline gear and the trip end

- 15** Delivery Date - Print the date that the fish were landed and a fish ticket produced.
- 16** Up (Retrieve) Date & Time (24 hour clock) - Print the month/date, and time that the gear was retrieved. "Set" and "up" dates may be different days.  
08:00am = 0800 1:00pm = 1300
- 17** Estimated Pounds of Sablefish RETAINED - Print the estimate in pounds of Sablefish landed, as well as the count.
- 18** RETAINED - Print the species name and the estimate (in **count & pounds**) for species retained.  
Example: If Aurora Rockfish are retained, report pounds and count with code **ARRA**. If fish are mixed with other minor slope rockfish, use the code **USLP**.  
All IFQ species 4 letter codes are provided on the "Individual Species Codes" list.
- 19** Estimated Pounds of Sablefish RELEASED - Print the estimate (in count & pounds) of the sablefish released/discarded.

- 20** RELEASED (Discarded) - Print the species code and the estimate (in **count & pounds**) of what was released (discarded).  
Record all fish released/discarded, including but not limited to prohibited species, species with a size limit or trip limit, and fish discarded because of lack of market.  
**Report pounds and count at the IFQ species level/ grouping.**  
For released **Pacific Halibut**, carefully report the count and your best weight estimation based the size of each fish.  
**For more recording space for released or retained catch:**  
- Cross out the column label in an unused catch column and print RELEASED or RETAINED in the in column heading, as needed.  
- \*Split an available pound/ count box from an existing column (see blackgill rockfish [BLGL] retained record on the example page).  
- Record the catch information on the next page, making sure to identify set/string number.

- 21** Vessel Operator's Signature  
- All captains must sign all logbook pages to show that information provided in the logbook is complete, accurate, and truthful.
- 22** Vessel Operator's Name - Print the name of the vessel operator (captain).
- 23** Comments – Record necessary comments about gear and catch, as well as things of interest to the captain such as the weather, sea condition, fish behavior, costs, markets, etc.  
- Describe the gear used if "other" is circled in #7 Gear.  
- Describe pot type if "other" is circled in #8a "Type of Pot".  
- If gear was lost, record the set # from which the gear was lost, 9b.
- 24** Fish Receiving Ticket Number – Record the delivery date and the unique 8-digit ticket number for each fish delivery.
